WRITTEN NOTIFICATION: Notification regarding Incidents

NC #001 Written Notification pursuant to FLTCA, 2021, s. 154 (1) 1.

Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 104 (1) (b)

The licensee has failed to ensure that a resident's substitute decision maker (SDM) was notified of an allegation of neglect within 12 hours of the licensee becoming aware of the allegation.

Rationale and Summary

An allegation of neglect was brought forward to the home regarding a resident. The resident's SDM was not notified.

The Administrator said that the resident's SDM should have been notified immediately.

By failing to notify the resident's SDM, they were not aware of the allegation of neglect.
