WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 131. Administration of drugs Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

s. 131. (2) The licensee shall ensure that drugs are administered to residents in accordance with the directions for use specified by the prescriber. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 131 (2).

Findings/Faits saillants:

- 1. The licensee did not ensure that a drug was administered to an identified resident in accordance with the directions for use specified by the prescriber.
- a) The physician wrote an order for a medication to be administered daily for 30 days for the identified resident. The resident received this medication for three days and did not receive it again until it was re-ordered almost three weeks later.
- b) As a result of the resident failing to receive this medication as prescribed, the resident was not able to receive a treatment that had been arranged for them.

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure that drugs are administered to residents in accordance with the the directions for use specified by the prescriber., to be implemented voluntarily.
