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Non-compliance with requirements under the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007 (LTCHA) was found. (A requirement under the LTCHA includes the requirements contained in the items listed in the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA.)

The following constitutes written notification of non-compliance under paragraph 1 of section 152 of the LTCHA.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 6. Plan of care Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

- s. 6. (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that there is a written plan of care for each resident that sets out,
- (a) the planned care for the resident:
- (b) the goals the care is intended to achieve; and
- (c) clear directions to staff and others who provide direct care to the resident. 2007, c. 8, s. 6 (1).

## Findings/Faits saillants:

[O. Reg. 79/10, s.6(1)(c)] The plan of care for an identified resident does not set out clear directions to staff who provide direct care. The resident has required one to one supervision in 2011 for responsive behaviour towards other residents. On an identified day in 2011, a personal support worker (PSW) was given verbal direction to provide one to one supervision throughout the night for the resident. The PSW did not follow the verbal direction and left the resident's room without first ensuring that someone else was monitoring the resident. Several minutes later, the resident was observed by registered staff to be wandering around the home area. The plan of care does not describe the necessary directions for staff regarding the details of one to one supervision. The incident was immediately reported to the management of the home and an investigation was conducted in accordance with Ontario Regulation 79/10.
