Inspection Summary/Résumé de l'inspection

The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Critical Incident System inspection.

This inspection was conducted on the following date(s): July 31, August 1, and 2, 2019.

The following Critical Incident System (CIS) intakes were inspected during this inspection:

**Log #026739-18 - related to falls prevention and management; and
Log #019275-18 - related to injury with unknown cause.**

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with the Assistant Administrator, the Director of Resident Care (DRC), Assistant Director of Resident Care (ADRC), Registered Nurses (RN), Registered Practical Nurses (RPN), Personal Support Workers (PSW), Social Worker (SW), and family members.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) conducted observation of staff and resident interactions and the provision of care, record review of health records, home's investigation records and staffing schedules.

The following constitutes written notification of non-compliance under paragraph 1 of section 152 of the LTCHA.

s. 107. (4) A licensee who is required to inform the Director of an incident under subsection (1), (3) or (3.1) shall, within 10 days of becoming aware of the incident, or sooner if required by the Director, make a report in writing to the Director setting out the following with respect to the incident:

4. Analysis and follow-up action, including,

- i. the immediate actions that have been taken to prevent recurrence, and**
- ii. the long-term actions planned to correct the situation and prevent recurrence.**

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The licensee has failed to ensure that when required to inform the Director of an incident under subsection (1), (3) or (3.1) shall, within 10 days of becoming aware of the incident, or sooner if required by the Director, make a report in writing to the Director setting out the following with respect to the incident:

- Analysis and follow-up action, including the immediate actions that have been taken to prevent recurrence.

On an identified date, critical incident system (CIS) report related to resident #002's injury was submitted to the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (MOHLTC).

Review of CIS report analysis and follow-up action revealed the long-term actions that were planned to correct the situation and prevent recurrence indicated:

- refer the resident to pharmacist to review medications and specific health issue.
- refer the resident to dietitian to review nutrition status and diet for specific health issue.
- to investigate the possible cause of the injury.

Interview with Director of Resident Care (DRC) #103 acknowledged that the above-mentioned CIS report had not been amended to include the outcome of the analysis and follow-up actions. [s. 107. (4) 4.]
