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Non-compliance with requirements under the Long-Term Care the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA.)

The following constitutes written notification of non-compliance under paragraph 1 of section 152 of the LTCHA.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 8. Policies, etc., to be followed, and records Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

s. 8. (1) Where the Act or this Regulation requires the licensee of a long-term care home to have, institute or otherwise put in place any plan, policy, protocol, procedure, strategy or system, the licensee is required to ensure that the plan, policy, protocol, procedure, strategy or system,

(a) is in compliance with and is implemented in accordance with applicable requirements under the Act; and (b) is complied with. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 8 (1).

Findings/Faits saillants:

1. An identified resident was admitted to the home in 2010.

At the time of admission the staff who processed the admission medication orders did not follow the homes policies regarding the Admission of New Residents and Medication Reconciliation.

These policies require staff to complete the top portion of the Best Possible Medication History Reconciliation/Admission Orders (BPMH) form with resident demographic information and then record a complete and accurate list of the residents current and pre-admission medications.

This information was not completed according to the homes policies, as the medications recorded on the BPMH form were medications identified for another resident and not medications for the identified resident.

This error was identified and corrected a few days later.

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance, to be implemented voluntarily.
