Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 34 (1) 3.

General requirements

s. 34 (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the following is complied with in respect of each of the organized programs required under sections 11 to 20 of the Act and each of the interdisciplinary programs required under section 53 of this Regulation:

3. The program must be evaluated and updated at least annually in accordance with evidence-based practices and, if there are none, in accordance with prevailing practices.

In accordance with O. Reg. 246/22 s. 34 (1) (3) the licensee shall ensure that the program and relevant policies shall be evaluated and updated annually in accordance with evidence-based practices and if there are none, in accordance with prevailing practices.

The licensee has failed to ensure that the falls prevention and management program was evaluated and updated annually.

Falls prevention and management

s. 54 (2) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that when a resident has fallen, the resident is assessed and that a post-fall assessment is conducted using a clinically appropriate assessment instrument that is specifically designed for falls. O. Reg. 246/22, s. 54 (2); O. Reg. 66/23, s. 11.

The licensee had failed to ensure that when the resident had a fall, that a post fall assessment was conducted using a clinically appropriate assessment instrument that was specifically designed for falls.
