Plan of care

s. 6 (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that there is a written plan of care for each resident that sets out,

(a) the planned care for the resident;

The licensee failed to ensure that fall prevention interventions applied to a resident were included in their plan of care. Interviews with home's staff denoted that resident utilized fall prevention interventions to mitigate the risk of falls, but the home omitted to include them in resident's plan of care.
