Inspection Summary/Sommaire d'inspection		
The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a complaint inspection regarding food services and laundry.		
During the course of the inspection, the inspector spoke with: the administrator, foodservice manager, environmental staff, chef, dietary aides, personal support workers, registered staff and residents.		
The inspector observed lunch service on March 21, 2011 in Brighton Home Area and reviewed all menu items and production counts for the week of March 21, 2011. The inspector reviewed minutes from the Food Committee meetings since October 2010 and spoke to a number of residents regarding the quality of Food services at the Home. The inspector reviewed the Homes' Laundry services and reviewed Resident's Record.

The following constitutes written notification of non-compliance under paragraph 1 of section 152 of the LTCHA.

Non-compliance with requirements under the *Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007* (LTCHA) was found. (A requirement under the LTCHA includes the requirements contained in the items listed in the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA.)

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg. 79/10, s. 71(2) (a)

The licensee shall ensure that each menu,

(a) provides for adequate nutrients, fiber and energy for the residents based on the current Dietary Reference Intakes (DRI's) established in the reports overseen by the United States National Academies and published by National Academy Press, as they may exist from time to time.

Findings:

1. Lunch Service March 21, 2011 in Brighton Dining room observed 6/11 portion sizes (54.5%) to be incorrect as per posted menu i.e. Cream of Tomato soup 120 ml. ladle served, menu indicates 180 mls. and minced parsley carrots #12 scoop served, menu indicates #10 scoop. Portion sizes observed were smaller than the posted menu. Therefore Residents were not provided adequate nutrients, fibre and energy based on the current Dietary Reference Intakes.

VPC - pursuant to the *Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007*, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance, ensuring, that menus provide adequate intake of nutrients based on the current Dietary Reference Intakes (DRI's), to be implemented voluntarily.
