Inspection Summary/Résumé de l'inspection

The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Complaint inspection.

This inspection was conducted on the following date(s): July 15 and 17, 2014.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with the General Manager, Director of Care, Neighbourhood Coordinator, 1 Registered Nurse, 1 Registered Practical Nurse, 3 Personal Support Workers, 1 Resident and 1 Family member.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) toured one home area and common area, observed resident care provision, resident/staff interactions, recreational activities and reviewed relevant residents' clinical records and plans of care.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 3. Residents' Bill of Rights



Specifically failed to comply with the following:

s. 3. (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the following rights of residents are fully respected and promoted:

11. Every resident has the right to,

i. participate fully in the development, implementation, review and revision of his or her plan of care,

ii. give or refuse consent to any treatment, care or services for which his or her consent is required by law and to be informed of the consequences of giving or refusing consent,

iii. participate fully in making any decision concerning any aspect of his or her care, including any decision concerning his or her admission, discharge or transfer to or from a long-term care home or a secure unit and to obtain an independent opinion with regard to any of those matters, and

iv. have his or her personal health information within the meaning of the Personal Health Information Protection Act, 2004 kept confidential in accordance with that Act, and to have access to his or her records of personal health information, including his or her plan of care, in accordance with that Act. 2007, c. 8, s. 3 (1).

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The licensee has failed to ensure that every resident has the right to have his or her personal health information within the meaning of the Personal Health Information Protection Act, 2004 kept confidential in accordance with that Act, as evidenced by:

The electronic medication administration records (eMAR) terminal was observed to be left open and the medication cart unattended in an identified area accessible to the public. Personal health information (PHI) was readily accessible.

A Registered staff member verified the eMAR terminal was not locked and PHI was accessible.

The Director of Care confirmed the expectation that residents' PHI should be kept confidential and not accessible. [s. 3. (1) 11. iv.]



Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure that residents' personal health information is kept confidential in accordance with that Act, to be implemented voluntarily.

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 231. Resident records

Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that,

(a) a written record is created and maintained for each resident of the home; and

(b) the resident's written record is kept up to date at all times. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 231.

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The licensee has failed to ensure that the resident's written record is kept up to date at all times as evidenced by:

A review of the Personal Care Observation and Monitoring forms for residents in an identified area revealed deficiencies in documentation for bathing as follows:

Residents # 01, 18 and 27 – missing documentation for 3/3 weeks (100%)

Residents # 02 ,03, 04 06, 17, 19, 20, 22, 26, 29, 31 and 32 - missing documentation for 2/3 weeks (66%)

Residents # 07, 09, 10, 12, 14, 16, 23 and 30 - missing documentation for 1/3 weeks (33%)

The deficiencies in documentation were confirmed by the Neighbourhood Coordinator.

The Director of Care confirmed the home's expectation that the resident's written record is kept up to date at all times. [s. 231. (b)]



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Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure that the resident's written record is kept up to date at all times, to be implemented voluntarily.
