During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with the Administrator, Director of Care(DOC), five Personal Support Workers (PSW), Clinical Managers, Support Services Manager, Laundry aide, three Registered Practical Nurses (RPN) and residents.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) Observed dining service on two floors, observed supplies on each floor, observed laundry area, observed government supplies, and reviewed resident health records for two complaint logs (002106 & 002215).

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 6. Plan of care Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

s. 6. (7) The licensee shall ensure that the care set out in the plan of care is provided to the resident as specified in the plan. 2007, c. 8, s. 6 (7).

# Findings/Faits saillants:

1. Interview of four PSW's on Oct.9 & 10, 2012 on two identified floors, indicated ten identified residents were provided personal hygiene and grooming during the 11pm-7am shift.

Review of the health records under plan of care on Oct.10/12 indicated under sleep patterns that resident #4, #5, #7& #8 indicated the residents preferred to get up at 08:00hrs.Resident #9 & #11 did not indicate the resident's sleep patterns or preferences.

The licensee failed to ensure that the care set out in the plan was provided to the resident as specified in the plan related to sleep patterns[s.6(7)].

### Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure that the care set out in the plan of care is provided to the resident as specified in the plan related to sleep patterns, to be implemented voluntarily.

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 229. Infection prevention and control program Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

s. 229. (4) The licensee shall ensure that all staff participate in the implementation of the program. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 229 (4).

### Findings/Faits saillants:

1. Observation of the clean storage rooms on Oct.9/12 on the 2, 3 and 4th floors indicated there were 6 hair brushes that were in use, unlabeled and stored with the new hair brushes.
