### **Inspection Summary/Résumé de l'inspection**



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**The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Complaint inspection.**

**This inspection was conducted on the following date(s): Nov.13, 14, and 18th,  
2014**

**Complaints 003068-14, 004324-14, 006353-14 concurrently were inspected.**

**During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with the Director of Long Term Care, 2 Directors of Resident Care, 2 Registered Nurses, 5 Registered Practical Nurses, 14 Primary Care Providers ( PCP's ), 2 Housekeeping Aides, and 1 Housekeeping Supervisor.**

**During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) made observations, reviewed housekeeping records, and reviewed floor replacement summary.**

**WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 3. Residents' Bill of Rights**



**Specifically failed to comply with the following:**

**s. 3. (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the following rights of residents are fully respected and promoted:**

**11. Every resident has the right to,**

**i. participate fully in the development, implementation, review and revision of his or her plan of care,**

**ii. give or refuse consent to any treatment, care or services for which his or her consent is required by law and to be informed of the consequences of giving or refusing consent,**

**iii. participate fully in making any decision concerning any aspect of his or her care, including any decision concerning his or her admission, discharge or transfer to or from a long-term care home or a secure unit and to obtain an independent opinion with regard to any of those matters, and**

**iv. have his or her personal health information within the meaning of the Personal Health Information Protection Act, 2004 kept confidential in accordance with that Act, and to have access to his or her records of personal health information, including his or her plan of care, in accordance with that Act. 2007, c. 8, s. 3 (1).**

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**Findings/Faits saillants :**



1. The licensee has failed to ensure that the resident's right to have his or her personal health information is (within the meaning of the Personal Health Information Protection Act, 2004) kept confidential, and access to his or her records of personal health information, including his or her plan of care, in accordance with that Act.

Observations revealed a physician document in a resident's electronic chart, on the computer and leave the nursing station without logging out of the computer, thus leaving the health care records for residents open on the computer.

Observations on another Resident Home Area revealed a member of the registered staff leave the nurses' station and leave a computer open in a resident's electronic chart.

Interview with a second member of the registered staff occurred after inspector showed the open computer with no one present in the nursing station to this staff member.

The staff member confirmed the computer was open to a resident's electronic chart but also shared it was left opened by another registered staff and walked away.

The first member of the registered staff returned to the nurses' station approximately 10 minutes later

Interview with the first member of the registered staff, that left the computer open, confirmed it was the home's expectation that she would not leave the computer open, giving access to the residents' health care records, when she is not in attendance. [s. 3. (1) 11. iv.]

***Additional Required Actions:***

***VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure the resident's right to have his or her personal health information (within the meaning of the Personal Health Information Protection Act, 2004) kept confidential, and access to his or her records of personal health information, including his or her plan of care, in accordance with that Act, to be implemented voluntarily.***
