WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 3. Residents' Bill of Rights

Specifically failed to comply with the following:

- s. 3. (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the following rights of residents are fully respected and promoted:
- 4. Every resident has the right to be properly sheltered, fed, clothed, groomed and cared for in a manner consistent with his or her needs. 2007, c. 8, s. 3 (1).

Findings/Faits saillants:



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1. The licensee failed to fully respect and promote the resident's right to be properly sheltered, and cared for in a manner that was consistent with his or her needs.

A resident's care needs changed requiring a different level of staffing supervision.

A review of the progress notes and the Administrator confirmed that the home did not provide the required staffing supervision, according to their policy "Resident's with Special Needs".

The Licensee had failed to ensure that the resident was properly sheltered and care for when their care needs changed.

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to fully respected and promoted the resident's right to be properly sheltered, fed, clothed, groomed and cared for in a manner that was consistent with his or her needs, to be implemented voluntarily.

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 8. Policies, etc., to be followed, and records

Specifically failed to comply with the following:

- s. 8. (1) Where the Act or this Regulation requires the licensee of a long-term care home to have, institute or otherwise put in place any plan, policy, protocol, procedure, strategy or system, the licensee is required to ensure that the plan, policy, protocol, procedure, strategy or system,
- (a) is in compliance with and is implemented in accordance with applicable requirements under the Act; and O. Reg. 79/10, s. 8 (1).
- (b) is complied with. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 8 (1).

Findings/Faits saillants:



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1. Where the Act or this Regulation requires the licensee of a long-term care home to have, institute or otherwise put in place any plan, policy, protocol, procedure, strategy or system, the licensee is required to ensure that the plan, policy, protocol, procedure, strategy or system, is complied with.

The Policy 4.11.10 Resident's with Special Needs Procedure:

- 7. Assess the resident and commence the assessment tools to track behaviour including the antecedent and consequences.
- 10. Behavioural Support Resource Team (BSRT) will monitor tools for data collection to further identify and individualize the care needs.

A review of Documentation showed that resident did not have an assessment tool to track behaviours and there was no data collected to identify the residents care needs from the BSRT.

The BSRT Nurse confirmed that an assessment tracking record should have been completed on the resident.

The Administrator confirmed that it is the homes expectation that they should have implemented an assessment tracking form and should have been initiated and reviewed by BSRT. [s. 8. (1) (b)]

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance institute or otherwise put in place any plan, policy, protocol, procedure, strategy or system, the licensee is required to ensure that the plan, policy, protocol, procedure, strategy or system, is complied with, to be implemented voluntarily.
