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The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Complaint inspection.

This inspection was conducted on the following date(s): September 20, 21, 22, 23 and 26, 2016.

The following inspections were completed concurrently: Log #023293-16 pertaining to an anonymous complaint of insufficient staffing, Log #024182-16 pertaining to an anonymous complaint of insufficient staffing, Log # 028062-16 pertaining to an anonymous complaint of missed resident baths, fluids lacking and staff working without credentials. Log #027662-16 pertaining to an anonymous complaint of insufficient care lacking. During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with the Administrator, the Director of Care (DOC), the Assistant Director of Care (ADOC), Two Registered Nurses (RN's), One Registered Practical Nurses (RPN), five Personal Support Workers (PSW's), six residents and two family members.

The inspector(s) also conducted a tour of the home and made observations of residents, activities and care. Relevant clinical records and plans of care for identified residents were reviewed. Inspector(s) observed meal and snack service, medication administration, resident /staff interactions, infection prevention and control practices, the posting of Ministry of Health and Long Term Care information.

The following Inspection Protocols were used during this inspection: Infection Prevention and Control Personal Support Services Prevention of Abuse, Neglect and Retaliation Snack Observation Sufficient Staffing

# WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 33. Bathing



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Specifically failed to comply with the following:

s. 33. (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that each resident of the home is bathed, at a minimum, twice a week by the method of his or her choice and more frequently as determined by the resident's hygiene requirements, unless contraindicated by a medical condition. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 33 (1).

# Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The licensee has failed to ensure that the residents were bathed, at a minimum, twice a week by the method of his or her choice, including tub baths, showers, and full body sponge baths, and more frequently as determined by the resident's hygiene requirements, unless contraindicated by a medical condition.

On September 21, 2016, a record review revealed nineteen percent of baths reviewed were missed.

An interview with the ADOC #104 confirmed the baths were missed and not made up and it is the homes expectation that the residents were to be bathed, at a minimum, twice a week by the method of his or her choice, including tub baths, showers, and full body sponge baths, and more frequently as determined by the resident's hygiene requirements, unless contraindicated by a medical condition. ### Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure that the residents are bathed, at a minimum, twice a week by the method of his or her choice, including tub baths, showers, and full body sponge baths, and more frequently as determined by the resident's hygiene requirements, unless contraindicated by a medical condition, to be implemented voluntarily.

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 8. Nursing and personal support services



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Specifically failed to comply with the following:

s. 8. (3) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that at least one registered nurse who is both an employee of the licensee and a member of the regular nursing staff of the home is on duty and present in the home at all times, except as provided for in the regulations. 2007, c. 8, s. 8 (3).

### Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The licensee has failed to ensure that there was at least one registered nurse who was an employee of the licensee and a member of the regular nursing staff on duty and present at all times.

On September 20, 2016, a review of the registered staff schedule revealed there was no Registered Nurse (RN) on duty in the home on July 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29 and 30, 2016, night shifts.

An interview with the Director of Care #100 on September 21, 2016, confirmed the fourteen night shifts were not covered by a Registered Nurse in July, 2016, and it was the homes expectation that there should have been at least one registered nurse who was an employee of the licensee and a member of the regular nursing staff on duty and present at all times.
