Inspection Summary/Résumé de l'inspection



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The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Complaint inspection.

This inspection was conducted on the following date(s): November 22, and 23, 2018.

Complaint log #030084-18 related to withholding approval for admission, had been inspected.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector conducted a tour of the home, reviewed the Central East Local Health Integration Network (CE LHIN)'s referral for long term placement and the refusal letter for admission.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with the Central East Local Health Integration Network (CE LHIN) Placement Coordinator and the Resident Services Coordinator (RSC).

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 44. Authorization for admission to a home

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Specifically failed to comply with the following:

s. 44. (7) The appropriate placement co-ordinator shall give the licensee of each selected home copies of the assessments and information that were required to have been taken into account, under subsection 43 (6), and the licensee shall review the assessments and information and shall approve the applicant's admission to the home unless,

(a) the home lacks the physical facilities necessary to meet the applicant's care requirements; 2007, c. 8, s. 44. (7).

(b) the staff of the home lack the nursing expertise necessary to meet the applicant's care requirements; or 2007, c. 8, s. 44. (7).

(c) circumstances exist which are provided for in the regulations as being a ground for withholding approval. 2007, c. 8, s. 44. (7).

s. 44. (9) If the licensee withholds approval for admission, the licensee shall give to persons described in subsection (10) a written notice setting out,

(a) the ground or grounds on which the licensee is withholding approval; 2007, c. 8, s. 44. (9).

(b) a detailed explanation of the supporting facts, as they relate both to the home and to the applicant's condition and requirements for care; 2007, c. 8, s. 44. (9).
(c) an explanation of how the supporting facts justify the decision to withhold approval; and 2007, c. 8, s. 44. (9).

(d) contact information for the Director. 2007, c. 8, s. 44. (9).

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The licensee had failed to comply with s. 44 (7) of the Long-Term Care Homes Act (LTCHA) whereby the licensee refused the application of applicant #001 for reasons other than provided for in the LTCHA.

The Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (MOHLTC) received a complaint on an identified date, related to the home withholding approval for admission of applicant #001.

At the time of the inspection, applicant #001 remained in the hospital.

A review of the Central East Local Health Integration Network (CE LHIN)'s referral for long term placement indicated applicant #001 was referred to Bay Ridges Long Term



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Care Centre (LTCC) on an identified date for admission.

A review of applicant #001's LHIN health assessment from an identified date, revealed the applicant had an identified medical condition, and required an identified care provision.

A review of the home's letter addressed to applicant #001 from the Resident Services Coordinator (RSC) of Bay Ridges LTCC indicated their application for placement at Bay Ridges LTCC had been declined at the time. The letter further indicated the home rereviewed applicant #001's health assessment and documents related to their change in health status, and had determined the home did not have the physical facilities required to meet the applicant's care needs related to their identified medical condition.

A telephone interview with the CE LHIN Placement Coordinator, indicated applicant #001 remained on the wait list for Bay Ridges LTCC, and that the home was originally included in their five homes of choice. The CE LHIN Placement Coordinator indicated the applicant was initially accepted to the home, however, on an identified date the CE LHIN received an update from the hospital indicating the applicant had an identified medical condition. The CE LHIN Placement Coordinator further indicated applicant #001 had been declined by the home due to their identified medical condition.

On-site observations conducted by Inspector #653 noted the home had rooms to accommodate applicant #001's medical requirements.

During an interview with the RSC on an identified date, the RSC indicated the home has an identified number of rooms suitable for the applicant. When asked by the inspector why the applicant had been refused admission to the home, the RSC stated applicant #001 had been refused because they had applied for a different identified room than what was required by their medical condition. The RSC further indicated the applicant required an identified room to meet their care requirements related to their identified medical condition.

As per observations, record reviews, and staff interviews, there was not enough information to substantiate that the home lacked the physical facilities necessary to meet the applicant's care requirements.

The licensee had failed to comply with s. 44 (7) of the Long-Term Care Homes Act (LTCHA) whereby the licensee refused the application of applicant #001 for reasons



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other than provided for in the LTCHA. [s. 44. (7)]

2. The licensee had failed to ensure that when withholding approval for admission, the licensee shall give a written notice setting out the ground or grounds on which the licensee is withholding approval; a detailed explanation of the supporting facts, as they relate both to the home and to the applicant's condition and requirements for care; an explanation of how the supporting facts justify the decision to withhold approval; and contact information for the Director.

The MOHLTC received a complaint on an identified date, related to the home withholding approval for admission of applicant #001.

At the time of the inspection, applicant #001 remained in the hospital.

A review of the CE LHIN's referral for long term placement indicated applicant #001 was referred to Bay Ridges LTCC on an identified date for admission.

A review of applicant #001's LHIN health assessment from an identified date, revealed the applicant had an identified medical condition, and required an identified care provision.

A review of the home's letter addressed to applicant #001 from the RSC of Bay Ridges LTCC indicated their application for placement at Bay Ridges LTCC had been declined at the time. The letter further indicated the home re-reviewed applicant #001's health assessment and documents related to their change in health status, and had determined the home did not have the physical facilities required to meet the applicant's care needs related to their identified medical condition.

As per record reviews and staff interviews, the written notice did not set out a detailed explanation of the supporting facts, as they relate both to the home and to the applicant's condition and requirements for care.

The licensee had failed to comply with s. 44 (9) of the LTCHA, whereby if the licensee withholds approval for admission, the licensee shall give to persons described in subsection (10) a written notice setting out, (a) the ground or grounds on which the licensee is withholding approval; (b) a detailed explanation of the supporting facts, as they relate both to the home and to the applicant's condition and requirements for care; (c) an explanation of how the supporting facts justify the decision to withhold approval;



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and (d) contact information for the Director. [s. 44. (9)]
