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The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Complaint inspection.

This inspection was conducted on the following date(s): December 12, 13, and 16, 2019.

During the course of this inspection, the inspector(s) reviewed all relevant clinical health records, the compliance plan, audits, relevant policies and procedures, and education documentation.

Please note that a Follow up inspection Log #022387-19, and a Critical Incident inspection Log #020623-19 were conducted concurrently with this inspection and are included in this report.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with the administrator, Director of Care, Assistant Director of Care and the complainant.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 50. Skin and wound care



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Specifically failed to comply with the following:

s. 50. (2) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that, (b) a resident exhibiting altered skin integrity, including skin breakdown, pressure

ulcers, skin tears or wounds,

(i) receives a skin assessment by a member of the registered nursing staff, using a clinically appropriate assessment instrument that is specifically designed for skin and wound assessment,

(ii) receives immediate treatment and interventions to reduce or relieve pain, promote healing, and prevent infection, as required,

(iii) is assessed by a registered dietitian who is a member of the staff of the home, and any changes made to the resident's plan of care relating to nutrition and hydration are implemented, and

(iv) is reassessed at least weekly by a member of the registered nursing staff, if clinically indicated; O. Reg. 79/10, s. 50 (2).

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The licensee failed to ensure that resident #005, who exhibited altered skin integrity, was reassessed at least weekly by a member of the registered nursing staff, when clinically indicated.

Resident #005 was admitted to the home on an identified date. A review of the admission assessments completed on the same day of admission indicated that this resident had an area of altered skin integrity.

The weekly skin assessments were reviewed for an identified two (2) week period of time and two (2) weekly skin assessments were not completed.

Upon further review of the skin assessments for resident #005, it was identified that this resident developed a second area of altered skin integrity on an identified date.

The weekly skin assessments were reviewed for an identified 25 week period of time, and three (3) weekly skin assessments were not completed.

In an interview conducted on December 16, 2019, with the Assistant Director if Care, it was confirmed that the identified areas of altered skin integrity were not reassessed weekly by a member of the registered nursing staff. [s. 50. (2) (b) (iv)]



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Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure that any resident who exhibits altered skin integrity, is reassessed at least weekly by a member of the registered nursing staff, when clinically indicated, to be implemented voluntarily.
