Non-compliance with requirements under the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007 (LTCHA) was found. (a requirement under the LTCHA includes the requirements contained in the items listed in the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA).

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 131. Administration of drugs

Specifically failed to comply with the following:

s. 131. (2) The licensee shall ensure that drugs are administered to residents in accordance with the directions for use specified by the prescriber. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 131 (2).

Findings/Faits saillants :



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1. The licensee failed to ensure that drugs were administered to a resident in accordance with the directions for use specified by the prescriber.

A physician's orders clearly indicated that a medication was to be held for an identified resident based on an assessment of that resident.

On a specific day, registered staff administered the medication prior to an assessment; once assessed it was found that the medication should not have been administered to the identified resident. This medication was not administered in accordance with the doctors orders and as such placed the resident at risk of harm.

On that same day, that same resident received two doses of a pain medication that was to be administered prior to a specific procedure only. Neither time that this medication was administered, was the procedure occurring or planned to occur.

This medication was not administered in accordance with the doctors orders and did cause the resident unnecessary discomfort related to the side effects of the administration of the medication. [s. 131. (2)]

Additional Required Actions:

***VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2)
the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for
achieving compliance to ensure that medications are administered to residents
according to the directions as specified by the prescriber, to be implemented
voluntarily.***
