WRITTEN NOTIFICATION: Air Temperature

NC #001 Written Notification pursuant to FLTCA, 2021, s. 154 (1) 1.

Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 24 (3)

The licensee has failed to ensure the temperature required to be measured was documented at least once every morning, once ever afternoon between 12 p.m. and 5 p.m. and once every evening or night.

Rationale and Summary:

A review of the Ambient Air Temperature log for a specific month showed the temperature was not documented at least once every morning, once ever afternoon between 12 p.m. and 5 p.m. and once every evening or night.

In an interview Administrator #100 said the expectation was for the air temperatures to be measured in the required areas and documented at least once every morning, once ever afternoon between 12 p.m. and 5 p.m. and once every evening or night.
