WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 78. Food service workers, training and qualificationsTraining and qualifications



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Specifically failed to comply with the following:

78. (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that food service workers hired on or after July 1, 2010, other than cooks to whom section 76 applies,

(a) have successfully completed or are enrolled in a Food Service Worker program at a college established under the Ontario Colleges of Applied Arts and Technology Act, 2002 or a Food Service Worker program provided by a registered private career college and approved by the Superintendent of Private Career Colleges under the Private Career Colleges Act, 2005;

(b) have successfully completed an apprenticeship program in the trade of Cook, Institutional Cook or Assistant Cook under the Apprenticeship and Certification Act, 1998 or the Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009; or

(c) have entered into a registered training agreement in the trade of Cook, Institutional Cook or Assistant Cook under the Apprenticeship and Certification Act, 1998 or the Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009.

Findings/Faits saillants :

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1. The licensee failed to comply with O.Reg. 79/10, s.78 (1), in that the licensee did not ensure that food service workers hired on or after July 1, 2010, have met one of the following requirements:

(a) have successfully completed or are enrolled in a Food Service Worker (FSW) program, as further described by the regulations;

(b) have successfully completed an apprenticeship program in the trade of Cook, Institutional Cook or Assistant Cook, as further described by the regulations; or
(c) have entered into a registered training agreement in the trade of Cook, Institutional Cook or Assistant Cook, as further described by the regulations.

In accordance with O.Reg. 78/10, s. 78 (4) and (5), in it understood that there are exceptions to the required qualifications of the Food Service Worker position and that consideration is also given to those with previous long term care home (LTCH) experience as a FSW prior to July 1, 2010.

FSW Staff member #S106 was hired after July 1, 2010 into the FSW position. The qualifications of staff member #106 were discussed with the Nutritional Manager and the employee file was reviewed. Staff member #106 does not met the exceptions of section 78(5) and has no previous FSW experience in a LTCH. It was confirmed that as of November 15, 2013, Staff member #106 had not successfully completed a FSW program and was not currently enrolled in a FSW program.

FSW Staff member #S105 was hired after July 1, 2010 into the FSW position. The qualifications of staff member #105 were discussed with the Nutritional Manager and the employee file was reviewed. Staff member #105 does not met the exceptions of section 78(5) and has no previous FSW experience in a LTCH. It was confirmed that as of November 15, 2013, Staff member #105 had not successfully completed a FSW program and was not currently enrolled in a FSW program.

It was noted by the inspector that the Offer of Employment for both Staff members #105 and 106 indicates that the offer of employment is conditional on the person enrolling in the FSW program within 3 years. Through this inspection the licensee has identified that this is not complaint with the requirements of O.Reg 78/10, s.78 (2). [s. 78. (1)]
