Authorization for admission to a home



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s. 51 (7) The appropriate placement co-ordinator shall give the licensee of each selected home copies of the assessments and information that were required to have been taken into account, under subsection 50 (6), and the licensee shall review the assessments and information and shall approve the applicant's admission to the home unless.

(b) the staff of the home lack the nursing expertise necessary to meet the applicant's care requirements; or

The licensee failed to comply with FLTCA, s. 51 (7) (b) when they withheld the applicant's approval for admission to the home.

The applicant's Behavioural Assessment Tool indicated the applicant exhibited specified responsive behaviours. The written notice to the applicant stated that the home lacked the nursing expertise needed to support the applicant's care needs. A staff member noted that the home did not have capacity to manage a high-risk resident who exhibited specified responsive behaviours and was not receiving specified care, given the home's staffing level and accessibility to community resources. The Placement Coordinator stated that the resident did not require specified care.
