 - (c) clear directions to staff and others who provide direct care to the resident. 2007, c. 8, s. 6 (1).**

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The written plan of care for one resident does not provide clear directions to staff providing direct care related to fall interventions. One resident, RN and RPN confirmed use of intervention equipment. The equipment was observed in use by the Inspector [s. 6. (1) (c)]

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance related to ensuring there is a written plan of care for each resident that sets out, clear directions to staff and others who provide direct care to the resident,, to be implemented voluntarily.

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 231. Resident records

Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that,

**(a) a written record is created and maintained for each resident of the home;
and**

(b) the resident's written record is kept up to date at all times. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 231.

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. Head injury routine was initiated post fall for one resident. The Head Injury Routine form located in the resident health record, is not dated. [s. 231. (b)]
