The licensee has failed to ensure that any standard or protocol issued by the Director with respect to infection prevention and control was implemented.

Specifically, that the IPAC Standard for Long-Term Care Homes, dated September 2023, was implemented. The IPAC Standard, under section 5.3 (c), states that policies and procedures for the implementation of Routine Practices and Additional Precautions including contact precautions are to be followed. These were not followed when a resident who was on additional precautions did not have a dedicated piece of equipment to use.
