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s. 102 (2) The licensee shall implement,

(b) any standard or protocol issued by the Director with respect to infection prevention and control. O. Reg. 246/22, s. 102 (2).

The licensee has failed to ensure that the infection prevention and control (IPAC) standard for long-term care homes, revised September 2023, was implemented in accordance with the standard. Specifically:

- Additional Precautions section 9.1 (f) Additional PPE requirements including appropriate selection application, removal and disposal.

During a shift, a Personal Support Worker (PSW) provided direct care to a resident who was on additional precautions in their room. The PSW did not wear the appropriate personal protective equipment while providing care to the resident.
