### **WRITTEN NOTIFICATION: Resident Hand Hygiene**

Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 102 (2) (b)



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Infection prevention and control program s. 102 (2) The licensee shall implement, (b) any standard or protocol issued by the Director with respect to infection prevention and control. O. Reg. 246/22, s. 102 (2).

The licensee failed to implement hand hygiene with residents prior to a meal service.

As per IPAC Standard 10.4 (h) issued by Director, the licensee was to have provided "support for residents to perform hand hygiene prior to receiving meals and snacks, and after toileting."

Prior to a meal service on a specific date, staff did not support residents in the dining room with hand hygiene.
