WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 5. Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the home is a safe and secure environment for its residents. 2007, c. 8, s. 5.

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The licensee failed to ensure that the home was a safe and secure environment for a resident.

Investigation notes indicated that a resident exhibited a responsive behaviour. The resident's care plan identified that they had interventions in place. Progress notes indicated that the resident had exhibited the responsive behaviour in the past. The Director of Care (DOC) in an interview, confirmed that the intervention was not in place. Without the intervention in place the resident was at risk for injury and harm related to environmental/safety hazards.

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure that the home is a safe and secure environment for its residents, to be implemented voluntarily.

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 6. Plan of care

Specifically failed to comply with the following:

s. 6. (11) When a resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised, (a) subsections (4) and (5) apply, with necessary modifications, with respect to the reassessment and revision; and 2007, c. 8, s. 6 (11).

(b) if the plan of care is being revised because care set out in the plan has not been effective, the licensee shall ensure that different approaches are considered in the revision of the plan of care. 2007, c. 8, s. 6 (11).

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The licensee failed to ensure that different approaches were considered in the revision of a resident's plan of care when their plan of care was reviewed and revised.

Investigation notes indicated a resident had a responsive behaviour. An interview with the Director of Care (DOC) confirmed that the resident continued to exhibit responsive behaviours and different approaches were not considered in the revision of the resident's plan of care. Because different approaches were not considered when the plan of care was ineffective, the resident was at risk for injury and harm related to environmental/safety hazards.

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure that different approaches are considered in the revision of a residents plan of care when their plan of care is reviewed and revised, to be implemented voluntarily.
