Inspection Summary/Résumé de l'inspection

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The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Follow up inspection.

This inspection was conducted on the following date(s): October 27-29, and November 2-5, 2020.

The following intake was inspected during this Follow Up Inspection:

- One intake related to CO#001 from inspection #2020_638542_0015, issued pursuant to O.Reg 79/10, s. 229. (8).

A Critical Incident Inspection (#2020_615759_0028) was conducted concurrently with this Follow up inspection.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with the Administrator, Assistant Director of Cares (ADOC), Registered Nurses (RN), Registered Practical Nurses (RPN), Personal Support Workers (PSW), the Director of Care Clerk, and screening staff.

The Inspector also conducted a daily tour of resident care areas, observed the provision of care and services to residents, reviewed relevant health care records, and reviewed licensee policies and procedures.

Non-compliance with requirements under the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007 (LTCHA) was found. (a requirement under the LTCHA includes the requirements contained in the items listed in the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA).

The following constitutes written notification of non-compliance under paragraph 1 of section 152 of the LTCHA.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 5. Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the home is a safe and secure environment for its residents. 2007, c. 8, s. 5.

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The licensee has failed to ensure that the home was a safe and secure environment for its residents specific to one staff member utilizing appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).

In accordance with Directive #3 for Long-Term Care Homes under the Long- Term Care Homes Act, 2007, issued under Section 77.7 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act (HPPA), R.S.O. 1990, c. H.7, long-term care homes were required to isolate new admissions under droplet and contact precautions for 14 days.

A resident who was newly admitted to the home, had a droplet and contact precautions signage on the wall outside of their room. The signage indicated that in addition to routine practices, a long-sleeved gown, gloves, mask and eye protection within 2 metres of the resident was required to be worn.

A PSW was observed entering the resident's room with no gown, eye covering, or gloves, thus increasing the risk of transmission of a potential incubating illness. During an interview with the homes Infection Prevention and Control (IPAC) lead, they confirmed that the PSW should have worn the appropriate PPE.
