**The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Critical Incident System inspection.**

**This inspection was conducted on the following date(s): August 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 30 and 31 and September 1, 2021.**

**The following logs were inspected as part of the Critical Incident System (CIS) inspection:**

- Log 004134-21 / CIS 2882-000006-21 was related to a significant change in a resident's health condition.**
- Log 007070-21 / CIS 2882-000007-21 was related to the administration of medications to a resident.**
- Log 007237-21 / CIS 2882-000008-21 was related to the fall of a resident.**
- Log 009265-21 / CIS 2882-000011-21 was related to an allegation of theft from a resident.**
- Log 011370-21 / CIS 2882-000013-21 was related to an allegation of staff to resident abuse.**

**During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with Personal Support Workers (PSWs), Registered Nursing Staff, a Housekeeper, a Screener, an Antigen Testing Staff, the Physiotherapist, the Clinical Care Coordinator, the Maintenance Manager, the Environmental Services Manager, the Infection Prevention and Control (IPAC) Practitioner, the Director of Care (DOC) and the Administrator.**

**During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) reviewed relevant documents including residents' health care records and observed the provision of care and services to residents, dining service, housekeeping services, COVID-19 screening, antigen testing and other IPAC measures and the recording and documentation of air temperatures.**

1. The licensee has failed to ensure that staff used safe transferring and positioning devices or techniques when assisting residents.

A resident required the use of a tilt wheelchair at all times for positioning.

According to the PSW who provided care to the resident, the resident was taken to their room for continence care. After continence care, the resident was left in their room seated in their wheelchair. The resident was later found on the floor and suffered an injury.

The DOC stated the chair was to be tilted to approximately a 45 degree angle. According to the CIS, "PSW reported that resident's W/C was slightly tilted at the time of the fall".

The resident's wheelchair was to be tilted at all times to keep them in the chair. The resident fell from their chair and sustained an injury. As such, staff did not use safe transferring and positioning devices or techniques when assisting the resident.

**Findings/Faits saillants :**

1. The licensee has failed to ensure that the home was a safe and secure environment for its residents.

A resident had an incidence of a fever. Three days later, isolation under contact droplet precautions was implemented, and a COVID-19 PCR swab was collected and an antigen test was conducted.

The IPAC Practitioner stated that the resident should have been isolated under contact droplet precautions immediately when they had a fever.

**Administration of drugs**

**Specifically failed to comply with the following:**

**s. 131. (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that no drug is used by or administered to a resident in the home unless the drug has been prescribed for the resident. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 131 (1).**

**Findings/Faits saillants :**

1. The licensee has failed to ensure that no drug was administered to a resident unless the drug was prescribed for the resident.

A resident was administered medications that were not prescribed to them and were prescribed to a different resident. The resident was sent to hospital for further assessment when there was a change in their health condition.

**s. 229. (4) The licensee shall ensure that all staff participate in the implementation of the program. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 229 (4).**

**Findings/Faits saillants :**

1. The licensee has failed to ensure that all staff participated in the implementation of the IPAC program.

A PSW brought a food tray to a resident who was isolated on contact droplet precautions. The PSW was observed feeding the resident without eye protection and gloves.

The IPAC Practitioner stated that the PSW should have been wearing eye protection and gloves while feeding the resident who was on contact droplet precautions.
