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The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Complaint inspection.

This inspection was conducted on the following date(s): January 29 and 30, 2019.

This complaint inspection, log number 001981-19, was conducted off site related to authorization for admission to a home.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 44. Authorization for admission to a home



Specifically failed to comply with the following:

- s. 44. (7) The appropriate placement co-ordinator shall give the licensee of each selected home copies of the assessments and information that were required to have been taken into account, under subsection 43 (6), and the licensee shall review the assessments and information and shall approve the applicant's admission to the home unless,**
- (a) the home lacks the physical facilities necessary to meet the applicant's care requirements; 2007, c. 8, s. 44. (7).**
 - (b) the staff of the home lack the nursing expertise necessary to meet the applicant's care requirements; or 2007, c. 8, s. 44. (7).**
 - (c) circumstances exist which are provided for in the regulations as being a ground for withholding approval. 2007, c. 8, s. 44. (7).**

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The licensee failed to ensure that following a review of the assessments and information provided, that they approved the applicant's admission to the home unless, the home lacked the physical facilities necessary to meet the applicant's care requirements or the staff of the home lacked the nursing expertise necessary to meet the applicant's care requirements.

Placement Services, of the HNHB LHIN, received a letter from the Administrator of the home, on a specified date in January 2019, addressed to applicant #001, regarding their application for admission to the home.

The letter identified that a decision was made that the home was "not the appropriate placement" for the applicant at the time and provided a statement related to their concerns.

A discussion was held with the Administrator regarding the applicant and the reason that their application was not accepted.

The Administrator, acknowledged that the home had both the physical facilities necessary to meet the care requirements of the applicant and the nursing expertise.

The Administrator acknowledged that the home had not identified acceptable grounds for withholding approval for applicant #001's admission to the home. [s. 44. (7)]
