The inspector reviewed registered nurse staffing schedules, reviewed clinical records related to falls, reviewed bed entrapment assessments and observed resident staff interactions.**

(3) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that at least one registered nurse who is both an employee of the licensee and a member of the regular nursing staff of the home is on duty and present in the home at all times, except as provided for in the regulations. 2007, c. 8, s. 8 (3).**

1. The licensee has failed to ensure that there was at least one registered nurse who was an employee of the licensee and a member of the regular nursing staff on duty and present at all times.

LTCHA, 2007, c.8, s 8.(3) has been the subject of a previous non-compliance WN, VPC issued November 28, 2013 (Inspection 2013\_171155\_0049).

LTCHA, 2007, c.8, s 8.(3) has been the subject of a previous non-compliance WN, CO #001 issued June 27, 2014 (Inspection 2014\_253514\_0018) with a compliance date of September 24, 2014.

LTCHA, 2007, c.8, s 8.(3) has been the subject of a previous non-compliance WN, CO #001 issued October 31, 2014 (Inspection 2014\_253514\_0029) with a compliance date of February 2, 2015.

A review of the registered nursing staff schedules from December 14, 2014 – February 27, 2015 (12 hour shifts) revealed that a registered nurse was not on duty and present at the home 67/152 shifts (44% of the time). The Director of Care confirmed these shifts were not covered by a registered nurse.

The home currently has five Registered Nurses and two are scheduled to start orientation in March 2015.

The Director of Care indicated that despite advertising and recruitment efforts the home has not been able to recruit enough staff to ensure there is at least one registered nurse on duty at all times. She indicated that she will be increasing the number of days she is in the home and full-time employment has been offered to another registered nurse. She also indicated that the home is trying to recruit a registered nurse through the new graduate initiative. [s. 8. (3)]
