Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 74 (2) (e) (i)

Nutritional care and hydration programs

- s. 74 (2) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the programs include,
- (e) a weight monitoring system to measure and record with respect to each resident,
- (i) weight on admission and monthly thereafter, and

The licensee has failed to comply with the home's Height and Weight Monitoring policy by not monitoring a resident's weight for the months of March and April 2024.

In accordance with O. Reg 246/22 s. 11 (1) b, where the Act or the Regulation requires the licensee of a long-term care home to have, institute or otherwise put in place any program, the licensee is required to ensure that the program is complied with.

Specifically, the staff did not comply with the licensee's policy titled Height and



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Weight Monitoring, which indicated that all residents will be weighed on admission and monitored at least once a month thereafter and weight and re-weight are recorded in the resident's health care records.
