The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Follow up inspection.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with the Nutritional Manager, Registered Dietitian,day Registered Nurse, Food Service Workers and Personal Support Workers.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) reviewed resident health records, food and fluid monitoring system including food and fluid records used by the home, diet lists and observed the lunch meal service on May 13, 2011.

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Non-compliance with requirements under the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007 (LTCHA) was found. (A requirement under the LTCHA includes the requirements contained in the items listed in the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA.)

The following constitutes written notification of non-compliance under paragraph 1 of section 152 of the LTCHA.

s. 8. (1) Where the Act or this Regulation requires the licensee of a long-term care home to have, institute or otherwise put in place any plan, policy, protocol, procedure, strategy or system, the licensee is required to ensure that the plan, policy, protocol, procedure, strategy or system,

(a) is in compliance with and is implemented in accordance with applicable requirements under the Act; and (b) is complied with. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 8 (1).

Findings/Faits sayants:

- 1. Under O.Reg 79/10, s.68(1)(d), the licensee shall ensure that the nutrition and hydration program include a system to monitor and evaluate the food and fluid intake of residents with identified risks.
- 2. The home's system to monitor food and fluid intake of residents includes the documentation of nutritional supplement intake at all nourishments and all meals.
- 3. The Nourishment Supplements Tick-off Sheets for May 1-12, 2011 were reviewed. The afternoon supplement for 11 residents was not documented for 8 out of 14 days. The morning supplement for 3 residents was not documented for 5 out of 14 days.
- 4. The Meal Supplement records from May 1-12 were reviewed for two residents, both care planned to receive nutritional supplement at all meals. The nutritional supplement for one resident was not documented for 23 out of 36 meals. The nutritional supplement for the second resident was not documented for 28 out of 36 meals.

TAKE NOTICE:

The Licensee has the right to request a review by the Director of this (these) Order(s) and to request that the Director stay this (these) Order(s) in accordance with section 163 of the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007.

The request for review by the Director must be made in writing and be served on the Director within 28 days from the day the order was served on the Licensee.

The written request for review must include,

- (a) the portions of the order in respect of which the review is requested;
- (b) any submissions that the Licensee wishes the Director to consider; and
- (c) an address for services for the Licensee.

When service is made by registered mail, it is deemed to be made on the fifth day after the day of mailing and when service is made by fax, it is deemed to be made on the first business day after the day the fax is sent. If the Licensee is not served with written notice of the Director's decision within 28 days of receipt of the Licensee's request for review, this(these) Order(s) is(are) deemed to be confirmed by the Director and the Licensee is deemed to have been served with a copy of that decision on the expiry of the 28 day period.

The Licensee has the right to appeal the Director's decision on a request for review of an Inspector's Order(s) to the Health Services Appeal and Review Board (HSARB) in accordance with section 164 of the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007. The HSARB is an independent tribunal not connected with the Ministry. They are established by legislation to review matters concerning health care services. If the Licensee decides to request a hearing, the Licensee must, within 28 days of being served with the notice of the Director's decision, give a written notice of appeal to both:
