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NON-COMPLIANCE REMEDIED

Non-compliance was found during this inspection and was **remedied** by the licensee prior to the conclusion of the inspection. The inspector was satisfied that the non-compliance met the intent of section 154(2) and requires no further action.

The licensee had failed to identify on their website, clear, comprehensible and prominent disclosure that the LTCH did not have air conditioning available in all the resident bedrooms.

The home remedied the non-compliance before the end of the inspection by adding to their website that there were no air conditioners in the residents' rooms.

O. Reg. 246/22, s. 23. (7) (Cooling Requirements)

The licensee has failed to ensure all resident bedrooms were served by air conditioning.

Rationale and Summary

In accordance with O. Reg. 226/22, s. 23. (7), the licensee was required to have on or before June 22, 2022, all resident bedrooms served by air conditioning.

The staff identified that the home did not have air conditioners installed into all the resident bedrooms, by June 22, 2022, and was still waiting for the delivery of their units. Also identified, the home did not submit a request to the Director for an extension past June 22, 2022, as required under s. 23 (9) (c).



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Review of Environmental Canada's website identified low risk to residents as Hornepayne's temperature had been below 26' Celsius (C), with no heat warnings in the area, between May 15 to September 8, 2022.
