- 9. Providing residents with any eating aids, assistive devices, personal assistance and encouragement required to safely eat and drink as comfortably and independently as possible. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 73 (1).

Findings/Faits saillants:

1. Food and fluids served at lunch meal December 17, 2012, were not at a temperature that was both safe and palatable to residents in the second floor dining room.

Hot food temperatures tested at the service point in the presence of a dietary aide were found to be: soup 120 degree Fahrenheit and pureed zucchini 110 degree Fahrenheit, hot food items should have been served at 140 degree Fahrenheit. Hot and cold foods not served at safe temperatures compromises palatability, reduces food intake and also increases the risk for food contamination. Several residents surveyed voiced concerns regarding hot foods served were not hot enough. [s. 73. (1) 6.]

2. The licensee did not ensure that the dining and snack service included, providing residents with any eating aids, assistive devices, personal assistance and encouragement required to safely eat and drink as comfortably and independently as possible, in relation to the following [(73(1) 9]

Resident # 1 was not provided with required level of assistance with eating and drinking at the observed lunch December 2012.

During the noon meal it was noted that resident # 1 was not eating the food that was provided. Staff was noted to be sitting at the table assisting another resident, however staff did not provide encouragement to this resident to eat. At approximately 1305 hours the staff person who started to assist this resident with eating left the dining room. The resident was left unattended for a lengthy period of time (approximately 20 minutes) with the food at the table. Another staff person at 1325 hours was noted feeding this resident cold food. The plan of care related to eating assistance reviewed on December 17, 2012 for this resident directs staff to provide "total assistance, one staff when feeding". Staff did not provided encouragement and personal assistance required as a result resident consumed inadequate amount of food. [s. 73. (1) 9.]

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance with ensuring residents are provided with personal assistance and encouragement required to safely eat and drink as comfortably and independently as possible, to be implemented voluntarily.
