During the course of the inspection, the inspectors: Audited the hand washing/sanitizing practices of the staff in the home. This was done primarily by observation and reviewing of policies and procedures for the Home.

Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that there is an infection prevention and control program for the home.

b) measures to prevent the transmission of infections.

Findings: Staff on Marian Villa Floors 1, 3, 4 & 5 were observed by both the Environmental Health Inspector and the Nursing Inspector to not perform actual handwashing after handling soiled linens or garbage. Hand Sanitizer was observed to be used sparingly in one case and in another used only when staff member observed Ministry staff nearby.
