Dining and snack service

- s. 79 (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the home has a dining and snack service that includes, at a minimum, the following elements:
- 5. Food and fluids being served at a temperature that is both safe and palatable to the residents.

The licensee has failed to ensure that meals were being served at a temperature that was both safe and palatable to the residents when the dietary staff did not record temperatures at the point of service for several meals or follow the process for corrective action when temperatures indicated they were out of range during the week of December 9-15th, 2024.
