- 1.All doors leading to stairways and the outside of the home must be,
- i. kept closed and locked,
- ii. equipped with a door access control system that is on at all times, and
- iii. equipped with an audible door alarm that allows calls to be cancelled only at the point of activation

Findings:

Numerous perimeter doors, leading to unenclosed outdoor areas are not equipped with a door access control system that allows the door to be locked to prevent unauthorized resident egress. These doors are all connected to the resident-staff communication system and are alarmed, however some doors (those located in the East wing) are also able to be cancelled at the nurse's station instead of at the point of activation only.

Pursuant to: Ontario Regulation 79/10, s. 9.1.i.,ii., and iii. Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the following rules are complied with:				
1.All doors leading to stairways and the outside of the home must be,				
i. kept closed and locked, ii. equipped with a door access control system that is on at all times, and				
iii. equipped with an audible door alarm that allows calls to be cancelled only at the point of activation				
Order:				

The licensee shall ensure that:

- 1. All doors leading to unenclosed outdoor areas are equipped with a door access control system that allows the doors to be locked (yet releasable upon fire alarm if designated as fire exits) and are to be connected to an audio visual enunciator.
- 2. The doors which are currently alarmed and are capable of being cancelled at the nurse's station and re-



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set at the door, must be engineered such that the point of cancellation can only be made at the door. All door alarms must be capable of being cancelled only at the point of activation.

Grounds:

Numerous perimeter doors, leading to unenclosed outdoor areas are not equipped with a door access control system that allows the door to be locked to prevent unauthorized resident egress. These doors are all connected to the resident-staff communication system and are alarmed, however some doors (those located in the East wing) are also able to be cancelled at the nurse's station instead of at the point of activation only.

The Order must be complied with by:

REVIEW/APPEAL INFORMATION

TAKE NOTICE:

The Licensee has the right to request a review by the Director of this (these) Order(s) and to request that the Director stay this (these) Order(s) in accordance with section 163 of the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007.

The request for review by the Director must be made in writing and be served on the Director within 28 days from the day the order was served on the Licensee.

The written request for review must include,

- (a) the portions of the order in respect of which the review is requested;
- (b) any submissions that the Licensee wishes the Director to consider; and
- (c) an address for service for the Licensee.

When service is made by registered mail, it is deemed to be made on the fifth day after the day of mailing and when service is made by fax, it is deemed to be made on the first business day after the day the fax is sent. If the Licensee is not served with written notice of the Director's decision within 28 days of receipt of the Licensee's request for review, this(these) Order(s) is(are) deemed to be confirmed by the Director and the Licensee is deemed to have been served with a copy of that decision on the expiry of the 28 day period.

The Licensee has the right to appeal the Director's decision on a request for review of an Inspector's Order(s) to the Health Services Appeal and Review Board (HSARB) in accordance with section 164 of the *Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007*. The HSARB is an independent group of members not connected with the Ministry. They are appointed by legislation to review matters concerning health care services. If the Licensee decides to request a hearing, the Licensee must, with 28 days of being served with the notice of the Director's decision, mail or deliver a written notice of appeal to both:
