have been taken into account, under subsection 50 (6), and the licensee shall review the assessments and information and shall approve the applicant's admission to the home unless, (b) the staff of the home lack the nursing expertise necessary to meet the applicant's care requirements.

The licensee has failed to ensure that when a resident applied for admission to the Long-Term Care (LTC) home, they were approved, unless the home lacked the nursing expertise required to meet the applicant's care requirements.

The written notice of withholding admission indicated lack of nursing expertise and included specified grounds.

The LTC home's Administrator and the Director of Care (DOC) both acknowledged that staff working in the home's secured area were trained in managing a resident's responsive behaviours.
