#### Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 150 (7)

Absences

s. 150 (7) A licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that when a resident of the home leaves for a medical absence or a psychiatric absence, information about the resident's drug regime, known allergies, diagnosis and care requirements is provided to the resident's health care provider during the absence.

The licensee failed to ensure that when a resident was on a medical leave of absence, all known diagnoses were communicated to the health care provider.
