### WRITTEN NOTIFICATION: Infection Prevention and Control

NC #001 Written Notification pursuant to FLTCA, 2021, s. 154 (1) 1.

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Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 102 (15) 1.

The licensee has failed to ensure the infection prevention and control lead worked 17.5 hours per week in that position.

**Rationale and Summary**

The infection prevention and control (IPAC) lead stated they worked eight hours per week as the IPAC lead. The Administrator acknowledged that the IPAC lead was not working 17.5 hours in the IPAC role, in the home.

There was low risk to the residents.
