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WRITTEN NOTIFICATION: Transferring and Positioning Techniques

NC #001 Written Notification pursuant to FLTCA, 2021, s. 154 (1) 1. Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 40 Transferring and positioning techniques s. 40. Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that staff use safe transferring and positioning devices or techniques when assisting residents.

The licensee has failed to ensure that the staff used safe transferring techniques on a specified date when they transferred resident without the use of their mobility device and the assistance of another staff. During the interview with the Director of Care (DOC), they confirmed that the resident's plan of care indicated that two staff and a device were required for safe transfer.
