WRITTEN NOTIFICATION: Directives by Minister

NC #001 Written Notification pursuant to FLTCA, 2021, s. 154 (1) 1. Non-compliance with: FLTCA, 2021, s. 184 (3)



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The licensee has failed to ensure that the operational or policy directives issued by the Minister, that applied to long term care were complied with, related to universal masking.

A Minister's Directive for COVID-19 directed the homes to ensure that all staff wore a well-fitted medical mask for the entire duration of their shift, while indoors, regardless of their COVID-19 vaccination status. A PSW was observed providing assistance to a resident in their room, with their mask below their nose. The Infection Prevention and Control (IPAC) lead indicated that staff were to wear a mask at all times in resident care areas, that cover their mouth and nose.

There was moderate risk to the resident.
