WRITTEN NOTIFICATION: Infection Prevention and Control Program

NC #001 Written Notification pursuant to FLTCA, 2021, s. 154 (1) 1.

Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 102 (2) (b)

The licensee has failed to ensure that a standard issued by the Director with respect to infection prevention and control was complied with in accordance with section 1.1 under the Minister's Directive: COVID-19 response measures for long-term care homes.

Specifically, the Licensee shall ensure the COVID-19: Self-Assessment Audit Tool for Long-term Care Homes and Retirement Homes, 2nd Edition: July 22, 2022, is used in accordance with COVID-19 Guidance Document for Long-Term Care Homes in Ontario.

Rational and Summary

Infection Prevention and Control (IPAC) lead, provided to Inspector records of the COVID-19: Self-Assessment Audit Tool for Long-term Care Homes and Retirement Homes (December 23, 2021 version). Audits were completed on May 25, 2023, August 10, 2023, and September 8, 2023.

During an interview with the IPAC lead, they acknowledged that they were not aware of the updated COVID-19: Self-Assessment Audit Tool, published on July 22, 2022, and the December 23, 2021 version was currently in use.

The use of the 1st edition of the COVID-19: Self-Assessment Audit Tool for Long-term Care Homes and Retirement Homes published on December 23, 2021 presents a potential risk in the preparedness and response to COVID-19 outbreaks within the home.
