WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 40. Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that each resident of the home is assisted with getting dressed as required, and is dressed appropriately, suitable to the time of day and in keeping with his or her preferences, in his or her own clean clothing and in appropriate clean footwear. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 40.

Findings/Faits saillants :

The licensee has failed to ensure that a resident was dressed appropriately and suitable for the time of day.

In the early evening, before dinner, a Registered Practical Nurse (RPN) discovered a resident dressed for bed. Two Personal Support Workers (PSW's) dressed the resident early for bed without checking the resident's care plan or collaborating with the registered staff. The resident was visibly upset and stated they were cold. The resident was returned to appropriate clothing.

Two PSW's, an RPN and the Director of Nursing (DON) were interviewed and all indicated that the resident should not have been dressed for bed early unless care planned or there was a special circumstance which involved collaboration with the registered staff, resident and/or power of attorney.
