During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with the licensee of Valley Park Lodge.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) reviewed Corporation Profile Reports, reviewed statements from SmartMeds Pharmacy to Valley Park Lodge and reviewed the contract between SmartMeds Pharmacy and Valley Park Lodge.

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Non-compliance with requirements under the Long-Term Care the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA.)

The following constitutes written notification of non-compliance under paragraph 1 of section 152 of the LTCHA.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 265. Non-arm's length transactions Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

- s. 265. (2) Subject to subsection (3), a licensee of a long-term care home shall not enter into a non-arm's length transaction unless.
- (a) the supplier has been selected from an open, fair and transparent competitive procurement process involving at least three unrelated bids and has demonstrated economy, efficiency and effectiveness for the money spent superior to that of the other bidders; and
- (b) the licensee keeps a record documenting the transaction and the details of the competitive procurement process. O. Reg. 79/10. s. 265 (2).
- s. 265. (6) Every licensee shall submit to the Director by March 31 in every calendar year, or at any other time required by the Director, a report that sets out, for the previous calendar year, or a time stipulated by the Director, every non-arm's length transaction for goods and services provided during that year or time, including a description of the services or goods received and the money spent for the goods and services. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 265 (6).

Findings/Faits saillants:

- 1. The licensee has not selected a supplier for purchasing specific nursing and personal care supplies for Valley Park Lodge in an open, fair and transparent competitive procurement process.
- On 2 occasions in January 2010, 1 occasion in April 2010, 2 occasions in May 2010, 1 occasion in July 2010, and 3 occasions in September 2010, the licensee entered into a non-arm's length transaction with SmartMeds Pharmacy Group, a supplier that it had not selected from an open, fair and transparent competitive bidding procurement process involving at least three unrelated bids as follows:
- a) The licensee purchased for the home nursing and personal care supplies, which are direct care goods, from SmartMeds Pharmacy Group
- b) SmartMeds Pharmacy Group is the business name for the Cedar Springs Pharmacy Inc.
- c) The licensee and Cedar Springs Pharmacy Inc. are associates within the meaning of s. 2(4) of the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007.
- -The identified individual is a director of the licensee
- -The same individual is also an officer, specifically the secretary and treasurer, of Cedar Springs Pharmacy Inc.
- d) The licensee paid money to acquire the supply of nursing and personal care supplies from SmartMeds Pharmacy Group pursuant to statements of transactions, which includes purchases.
- e) The licensee paid a maximum of \$36.00 on a transaction, in September 2010.
- 2. The licensee failed to submit to the Director by March 31, 2011, a report that set out, for 2010, every non-arms length transaction for goods provided during 2010, including a description of the goods received and the money spent for the goods.

During an interview with the licensee and statements provided by the licensee from SmartMeds Pharmacy to the longterm care home, Valley Park Lodge, it was confirmed that the licensee entered into a non-arms length transaction on a total of 4 occasions between July 1, 2010 and December 31, 2010, for the provision of goods. The licensee has failed to submit to the Director a report of these transactions, as of October 20, 2010.
