CMOH and MOH

s. 272. Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that all applicable directives, orders, guidance, advice or recommendations issued by the Chief Medical Officer of Health or a medical officer of health appointed under the Health Protection and Promotion Act are followed in the home.

The licensee has failed to ensure that all hand sanitizer in care areas of the LTCH are not expired. On a specific date, hand sanitizer was noted in three care areas to be expired.
