The purpose of this inspection was a result of identification of additional non-compliance statements unrelated to the complaint inspection conducted at the same time.

During the course of the inspection, the inspectors spoke with: The Acting Administrator, Director of Nursing, Environmental Services Supervisor, Chartwell's Environmental Corporate Consultant, President of the Resident Council, front-line nursing staff, registered staff and residents.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s): conducted a walk-through of communal tub and shower rooms, resident rooms and recorded air and water temperatures.

The following Inspection Protocols were used during this inspection: Accommodation- housekeeping

The following constitutes written notification of non-compliance under paragraph 1 of section 152 of the LTCHA.

Non-compliance with requirements under the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007 (LTCHA) was found. (A requirement under the LTCHA includes the requirements contained in the Items listed in the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA.)

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8 s. 15(2)(a). Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that, the home, furnishings and equipment are kept clean and sanitary;

Findings:

- 1. Bath tubs and commodes were soiled with hair, dust and debris on several floors throughout the home, (9th, 7th, 6th, 5th)
- 2. Feces were found on the floor of the shower stall in the 9th floor shower room.
- 3. Feces were found on the toilet seat in the tub room in the 6th floor tub and shower room.

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the *Long-Term Care Homes Act*, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure bath tubs, shower stalls and bathing equipment are maintained in a clean and sanitary state. This plan is to be implemented voluntarily.

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with O. Reg. 79/10 s. 87(3). The licensee shall ensure that a sufficient supply of housekeeping equipment and cleaning supplies is readily available to all staff at the home.

Findings:

- 1. Disinfectant for staff use was not present in the 5th and 7th floor tub/shower rooms.
- 2. A container of wipes for disinfecting equipment was available in the tub/shower room on 9th floor, however, could not be used as they were totally dry. There was no other disinfectant available.

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure there is a supply of disinfectant available at all times for staff to use on tub/shower equipment. This plan is to be implemented voluntarily.



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WN #3: The Licensee has failed to comply with O. Reg. 79/10 s. 90(2)(g). The licensee shall ensure that
procedures are developed and implemented to ensure that, the temperature of the water serving all
bathtubs, showers, and hand basins used by residents does not exceed 49 degrees Celsius, and is
controlled by a device, inaccessible to residents, that regulates the temperature;

Findings:

- 1. Bath tub water temperatures were noted to exceed 49 degrees Celsius. Water temperatures reached a maximum of 54 degrees Celsius in the following bath tubs and showers: (9th, 8th, 7th, 5th).
- 2. Resident room 814 bathroom water temperature reached a maximum of 51C.
- 3. Sink water temperature in the living room on 8th floor 50.2'C.

WN#4: The Licensee has failed to comply with O. Reg. 79/10 s87 (2) (b). As part of the organized program of housekeeping under clause 15 (1) (a) of the Act, the licensee shall ensure that procedures are developed and implemented for, cleaning and disinfection of resident care equipment, such as whirlpools, tubs, shower chairs, and lift chairs and supplies and devices, including personal assistance services devices, assistive aids, and positioning aids and contact surfaces, using hospital grade disinfectant and in accordance with manufacturer's specifications;

Findings:

- 1. Disinfectant for staff use was not present in the 5th and 7th floor tub/shower rooms.
- 2. A container of wipes for disinfecting equipment was available in the tub/shower room on 9th floor, however, could not be used as they were totally dry. There was no other disinfectant available.
- 3. Bath tubs and commodes were soiled with hair, dust and debris on several floors throughout the home. (9th, 7th, 6th, 5th)
- 4. Feces were found on the floor of the shower stall in the 9th floor shower room.
- 5. Feces were found on the toilet seat in the tub room in the 6th floor tub and shower room.

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REVIEW/APPEAL INFORMATION

TAKE NOTICE:

The Licensee has the right to request a review by the Director of this (these) Order(s) and to request that the Director stay this (these) Order(s) in accordance with section 163 of the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007.

The request for review by the Director must be made in writing and be served on the Director within 28 days from the day the order was served on the Licensee.

The written request for review must include,

- (a) the portions of the order in respect of which the review is requested;
- (b) any submissions that the Licensee wishes the Director to consider; and
- (c) an address for service for the Licensee.

When service is made by registered mail, it is deemed to be made on the fifth day after the day of mailing and when service is made by fax, it is deemed to be made on the first business day after the day the fax is sent. If the Licensee is not served with written notice of the Director's decision within 28 days of receipt of the Licensee's request for review, this(these) Order(s) is(are) deemed to be confirmed by the Director and the Licensee is deemed to have been served with a copy of that decision on the expiry of the 28 day period.

The Licensee has the right to appeal the Director's decision on a request for review of an Inspector's Order(s) to the Health Services Appeal and Review Board (HSARB) in accordance with section 164 of the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007. The HSARB is an independent group of members not connected with the Ministry. They are appointed by legislation to review matters concerning health care services. If the Licensee decides to request a hearing, the Licensee must, with 28 days of being served with the notice of the Director's decision, mail or deliver a written notice of appeal to both:
