Non-compliance with requirements under the Long-Term Care the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA.)

The following constitutes written notification of non-compliance under paragraph 1 of section 152 of the LTCHA.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 30. General requirements Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

s. 30. (2) The licensee shall ensure that any actions taken with respect to a resident under a program, including assessments, reassessments, interventions and the resident's responses to interventions are documented. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 30 (2).

## Findings/Faits saillants:

1.An identified residents' Medication Administration Record for July 29th, 2011 required eight drugs to be given daily: These drug interventions were not signed or documented as being given to the identified resident on the day shift of July 29th, 2011

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 68. Nutrition care and hydration programs Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

- s. 68. (2) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the programs include,
- (a) the development and implementation, in consultation with a registered dietitian who is a member of the staff of the home, of policies and procedures relating to nutrition care and dietary services and hydration;
- (b) the identification of any risks related to nutrition care and dietary services and hydration;
- (c) the implementation of interventions to mitigate and manage those risks;
- (d) a system to monitor and evaluate the food and fluid intake of residents with identified risks related to nutrition and hydration; and
- (e) a weight monitoring system to measure and record with respect to each resident,
- (i) weight on admission and monthly thereafter, and
- (ii) body mass index and height upon admission and annually thereafter. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 68 (2).

## Findings/Faits saillants:

Resident A deemed at high nutritional risk by the home's registered dietitian r did not have all food and fluid monitored and evaluated between July 29th and July 31st, 2011.

Residents' A and C deemed at at moderate nutritional risk by the home's registered dietitian did not have all food and fluid monitored and evaluated July 30th and 31st, 2011 [r. 68. (2) (d)]
