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Non-compliance with requirements under the Long-Term Care the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA.)

The following constitutes written notification of non-compliance under paragraph 1 of section 152 of the LTCHA.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 71. Menu planning Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

- s. 71. (3) The licensee shall ensure that each resident is offered a minimum of,
- (a) three meals daily;
- (b) a between-meal beverage in the morning and afternoon and a beverage in the evening after dinner; and
- (c) a snack in the afternoon and evening. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 71 (3).

Findings/Faits saillants:

1. An identified resident who was not feeling well and remained in her room for lunch on an identified day reported that staff did not offer her a lunch meal. A second identified resident remained in her room during lunch on an identified day was not offered a lunch meal but a cheese sandwich and a drink.[r.71.(3)(a)].

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 218. Orientation

For the purposes of paragraph 11 of subsection 76 (2) of the Act, the following are additional areas in which training shall be provided:

- 1. The licensee's written procedures for handling complaints and the role of staff in dealing with complaints.
- 2. Safe and correct use of equipment, including therapeutic equipment, mechanical lifts, assistive aids and positioning aids, that is relevant to the staff member's responsibilities.
- 3. Cleaning and sanitizing of equipment relevant to the staff member's responsibilities. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 218.

Findings/Faits saillants:

1. An identified registered staff reported that training related to safe and correct use of a identified piece of therapeutic equipment was not part of their orientation.

Director of Care stated that a demonstration of the identified equipment is part of the orientation for registered staff.[r. 218.2.1
