INSPECTION RESULTS

WRITTEN NOTIFICATION: Infection Prevention and Control

NC #001 Written Notification pursuant to FLTCA, 2021, s. 154 (1) 1.

Non-compliance with: O.Reg. 246/22, s. 102 (15) 1.

The home has failed to ensure that the designated infection prevention and control lead worked regularly in that position on site for at least 17.5 hours per week.

Summary and Rationale:

The Long-Term Care Manager indicated that the Acute Care Nurse Manager was the temporary IPAC lead for the home.

A Registered Nurse (RN) reported they were the Acute Care Nurse Manager for the hospital and also worked as the IPAC lead for the long-term care unit. They said they were unable to provide an exact number of hours that they worked as the IPAC lead, but thought it was approximately two hours per week.
