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Non-compliance with: FLTCA, 2021, s. 6 (10) (b)

Plan of care

s. 6 (10) The licensee shall ensure that the resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised at least every six months and at any other time when,
(b) the resident's care needs change or care set out in the plan is no longer necessary;
or

A resident's plan of care was not revised and updated accordingly when their care needs for a specific intervention was no longer necessary.

NC #002 Written Notification pursuant to FLTCA, 2021, s. 154 (1) 1.

Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 55 (2) (b) (iv)

Skin and wound care

s. 55 (2) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that,
(b) a resident exhibiting altered skin integrity, including skin breakdown, pressure injuries, skin tears or wounds,
(iv) is reassessed at least weekly by an authorized person described in subsection (2.1), if clinically indicated;

A resident with altered skin integrity did not receive a weekly skin assessment for a period of time.
