WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 6. Plan of care

Specifically failed to comply with the following:

s. 6. (3) The licensee shall ensure that the plan of care covers all aspects of care, including medical, nursing, personal support, nutritional, dietary, recreational, social, restorative, religious and spiritual care. 2007, c. 8, s. 6 (3).

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The licensee did not ensure that the plan of care for one resident covers all aspects of care, including medical, nursing, personal support, nutritional, dietary, recreational, social, religious and spiritual care. Review of the health record for one resident and interview with three staff confirm the resident has displayed a behaviour that is not referenced in the plan of care.[s. 6. (3)]



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WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 231. Resident records

Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that,

(a) a written record is created and maintained for each resident of the home; and

(b) the resident's written record is kept up to date at all times. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 231.

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The licensee did not ensure that one resident's written record is kept up to date at all times. Review of the health record for one resident and interview with two staff confirm the resident has been experiencing a medical concern. Progress notes completed by the physician refer to the continued medical concern. Progress notes completed by registered personnel do not reference dates and times of the medical concern. [s. 231. (b)]
